In the month of April, we will be back worshipping in our sanctuary. The first phase of our Renew, Restore, Rejuvenate Capital Campaign renovation is complete. The elevator is elevating. The nave received its facelift. Although we are not done with the total scope of our projects, I certainly breathed a sigh of relief that this first phase is finished.

When I returned from Europe I wasn't sure what I would be returning to at Zion. I knew the Fellowship Hall had been staged according to a diagram I drew, I can vaguely remember worshipping downstairs during the New Century Renovation twenty-some years ago, but what would it feel like now? Would worship in folding chairs and under fluorescent lights impact our sacrifice of praise? Would the setting influence our people's desire to come on the weekend and participate?

Looking back at the past three months, I believe this time of displacement has been a blessing for us in the Epiphany and Lenten seasons. The most obvious blessing to my eyes has been the amount of social interaction that I see between folks before and after the services. I know these conversations also occur when we're in the sanctuary, and frankly I have no data points to measure this observation, but it feels like there is more sharing happening as we function in the Fellowship Hall. It warms my soul. It's a mark of a healthy community. As we transition back upstairs, please don't allow the pews to get in the way of spending time and conversation with those around you.

The most obvious blessing that I heard has been in our singing. Again, I had no idea what to expect because of the changes. There's the lack of organ to support us and the acoustics in the Fellowship Hall are different. But, as it turns out, the low ceiling in that space makes us sound pretty strong. I pray that we will continue to find our voices as we move back upstairs.

In all these changes I thank you for your spirit and your patience. I know worship felt different, but the people of Zion have handled the disruption well. Now that our winter has ended we may blossom into something new in our refreshed space. May we also build off the blessings encountered during our time worshipping God in our Fellowship Hall. Sing! Visit! Continue to support one another as the holy people of God. Continue to make a joyful noise to the Lord.


