Just like you I have followed the capital campaign as we planned, paused for Covid (almost 3 years), raised funds (more than enough) and then started stripping the church in preparation for the painters in the sanctuary. A call for help went out and, did you know, several angels appeared!

Did you know that Mike Jones drove 3 hours east (and back) to borrow his father's trailer for the communion rail travel to New Holland?

Did you know that the Saxton Church and Pastor Rusty Chamberlain have a sister church in Kentucky that got flooded? The Saxton Church, at their cost, will take the pews to Kentucky. Talk about joyous generosity!

Did you know that the pews weighed a great deal and had length that required maneuvering around corners and down the steps to get out the door?

Did you know that the average age of folks doing this heavy lifting and step climbing happens to be 60?

Did you know that Zion filled a dumpster with all the demolition debris and a clean out of the nursery accompanied this project as well?

BLOOD DRIVE Postponed


We Need Your Blood, but not quite yet!!


