The Life of Zion



#### **ITEMS NEEDED FOR EACH KIT:**

- 1. One light/medium weight bath size towel (dark color preferred)
- 2. Two bath size bars of soap (in original wrapping)
- 3. One metal nail clipper (remove packaging)
- 4. One toothbrush (in original package)(or if multi pack, put toothbrushes in a business size envelope and seal)(no plastic bags or wrap)
- 5. One sturdy comb (not in package)

# DO NOT ADD ADDITIONAL ITEMS OR LEAVE OUT ANY ITEMS LISTED.

Wrap items in the towel and tie securely with yarn. Do not enclose items in plastic bags. Bring completed kits to the church library by Sunday, October 29<sup>th</sup>.

# CONFIRMATION COURSES






snacks, and individual packs of cookies. Homemade cookies are still welcome and can be put in smaller bags or our volunteers can

# Pre-register with Zion today! 8th-12th Graders

The time for Zion to register with the ELCA for the 2024 National Youth Gathering is fast approaching! We are looking forward to another amazing experience together. Sign youth up by pre-registering with us at Zion today. (Pre-registered youth and families will receive registration packets at a later date).

Zion youth attending the Gathering will:

Gathering and worship with thousands of Christian youth and leaders. Meet young people from all over the country! Be challenged to see things differently. Have a great time touring New Orleans. Serve the local community. Travel by plane and be housed in one of the city's hotels. Eat lots of great food!

Families will make three payments for the National **Youth Gathering.** The cost for every youth who attends is split between fundraising, the congregation, and families. While we can't give an exact cost to families at this time, we can say that families will not pay more than a total of \$600 per youth. This \$600 will be split into a \$100 deposit at registration and two even payments made between now and the Gathering. Families will be made aware of payment due dates at least one month in advance. (Families paid a total of \$550 per youth in 2018). The cost includes all travel expenses, Gathering fees, group T shirts, housing, and meals. Please contact us if financial assistance can help your youth get to the Gathering! Youth and families are expected to participate in fundraising as needed and attend any pre-Gathering events (dates will be given at least a month in advance). Youth should keep their calendar open for a few days prior to and after the Gathering for possible travel scheduling. Zion adults (including Ryan and Pastor Dave) will attend the 2024 Gathering with the Zion group. Friends are welcome with the understanding they will participate in fundraising and pre-Gathering events.
