July kitchen dates are July 7 and 21. we made 4067 meals in our second year of operation. The total number of donated meals is 8080, since our beginning. Zion's partnership with the Central PA Food Bank enables us to purchase goods at a significant discount, allowing us to help more individuals. Recovery Walk is August 2, and could use volunteers. The Salvation Dinner is the week of 8-10-25, and the first Afterburner is on 8-22-25.
