There were 2 funerals - Ginny Erb, and Barbara Sheehan. Synod conference meetings, and leading Reconciliation has been very fruitful. Trained as a coach, Pr. Dave met with a seminarian who has a four point congregation. Charlean Rodgers, who heads up the kitchen - needs drivers to help her get food sometimes. We had 260-280 people on Easter weekend.

Adult – Ruth Lucey	May 1 - Blood Drive is the next thing. Christina Pavlock did a nice bulletin board. Signing up volunteers for walkers and greeters. If Taize Tuesday has run its course, we could have a Wednesday Bible study followed by a meal during Lent. As an opportunity for fellowship and worship, we discussed the possibility of sometimes combining the two Sunday services to a 10:00 service followed by a potluck. The 5th Sunday of a month might be a good time to try. Saturday night service could come to their regular service, then the meal on Sunday.
